Please review this guide thoroughly prior to starting your CCA application

- To complete the Application for Admission to Community College of Aurora, you will need the following information (**if applicable**):
 - Social Security number or ITIN
 - Green Card or Alien Registration Number (if you are a Permanent Resident)
- If you are claiming In-State tuition you will need the following to complete the Residency section: (**if you are under 23 years old you may need to provide this information for your parent or legal guardian**)
 - When did your parent/guardian move to Colorado?
 - Has your parent/guardian been registered to vote in Colorado for the past year or more?
 - Did your parent/guardian file Colorado taxes this year?
 - Did your parent/guardian file Colorado taxes last year?
 - Does your parent/guardian have a Driver's License/Permit or State Identification Card? If yes, what is the number, what state is it issued from, and what is the date of issue or renewal?
 - Does your parent/guardian have a motor vehicle registered in Colorado for the past year? If yes, what is the date of your parent/guardian's Colorado Motor Vehicle Registration?


Step 8
