Seniors

Make sure to update your college and scholarship information on Naviance. When you have been accepted into any college or received any scholarship, please update this on your Naviance.

To update your college acceptance in Naviance: 1. Click on the "College" tab. 2. Select "Colleges I'm applying to" 3. Under the "Results" column click on the pencil to update the result to Accepted for each college you are accepted to. 4. Scroll to the bottom and click on "Update Applications."

- If this is not done, you will not receive your College Acceptance Pennant that's hung up in the CCC Window.

To update scholarship information in Naviance: 1. Click on the "Colleges" tab. 2. Select "Scholarship Applications" 3. Click the pink "+" button in the top right 4. Pick the scholarship, if the scholarship is from a specific school pick "INSTITUTIONAL Scholarship" 5. Change Award Status to Awarded 5. Put the amount 6. Click "Add Scholarship"

Application with January 1st and 15th Deadlines

If you are applying to a college/university that has a January 1st deadline be aware that this date occurs during Winter Break. Do the following to make sure everything is sent on time:

- Talk to any teacher about completing letters of recommendation and teacher evaluations. Ask teachers to have their documents uploaded into Naviance by **Monday, December 17th**.
- Talk to your counselor. Ask him/her to have their documents uploaded into Naviance by **Monday, December 10th**.
- **IMMEDIATELY** request your transcripts through Naviance. There is a 5-day processing time frame.
- **Please let your counselor know if you are applying via the Common App to any school**
- Match your Common App with Naviance by **Monday, December 10th**.
- Everything needs to be completed by the end of the day **Monday, December 17th**, so that Mrs. Knower can send everything by Thursday, December 20th. She will **NOT** be processing transcripts or application materials over Winter Break.

Step two: Meet with your counselor to verify qualifying test scores (ACT, SAT, AP or ACCUPLACER), grade waivers, discuss course offerings, and plan your schedule. Check Naviance messages, your school Gmail account, RHS Counseling Remind texts, and the CE Bulletin Board near the Counseling Office for ACCPULACER test dates/info.

Step three: Complete course registration and CE Agreement. New for Spring 2019 high school CE course registration is through DualEnroll online. Registration date/times TBD.

Step four: Verify that your CE course has been added into Infinite Campus by your counselor.
